- 3. Please send a leave application addressed to the principal through the grade- teacher prior to the absence of your ward duly attested by you. Half-day leave is not allowed.
- 4. Please don't send your ward to school when he/she is suffering from any infectious disease like cough and cold
- 5. Parents are expected to attend all parent-teacher meeting held in the school from time to time
- 6. Please ensure that the residential and official addresses with phone numbers are correct. This is required to establish efficient communication all round
- 7. Please see that your ward participates in all school activities sports, games and other co-curricular activities
- 8. Leave of absence will be granted only in case of emergency



Ask your parents to read and sign the Almanac and complete the closure record.

- Carry it with you every day. It is needed for you to record homework, achievements and other information.
- It is a useful means of communication between the teachers and the parents-as well as for your own use.
- You will be required to show your Almanac to your teachers.
- Don't decorate or cover the Almanac.
- At all times the student should possess the school Almanac. In case of loss of the Almanac, the student is required to purchase the same again.



- Involve your children in daily house-hold chores and encourage them to ask questions.
- Encourage your children to take decisions for solving little problems independently and to learn from mistakes. This will enable the children to understand that mistakes are part and parcel of our day to day work.
- Children enjoy different things and we should encourage them to explore these areas.
- All like winning and whenever you play with your children let them win at times so that they experience the pleasure and pride in doing well. Inculcate the concept of fair game.
- Share your good experiences with them and listen to their fairy tale stories and simple illustrations with interest. It creates wonderful bonding.
- Let your children explain parts of their lessons or probably their simple ways at solutions to family issues. This will help them develop sequencing of their thoughts and will also make them understand "why" and "why not".
- If your child is enjoying something and having fun playing (and maybe you are not), let him/her be. The children need to live their age.
- Your children are unique and individuals with their own strengths and limitations. Avoid comparisons and give your children the opportunities for developing their potential to the fullest.
- As the medium of instruction of the school is English, students should be motivated to converse in English at home also. Please encourage your ward to watch only useful programmes on T.V.
- Please avoid criticizing the school or teacher in the presence of your child. You are welcome to put forth your suggestions and complaints at the school reception or via e-mail.
- Parents must check the school website periodically in order to remain updated with the school activities.
- The school conducts educational trips and tours to nearby places as well as to places of interest outside
 the state. These programmes are necessary for the holistic development of the child and as per the
 prescribed norms. Parents are urged to send their wards as these programmes are part of the project
 work. Based on the performance of their ward in such activities, marks/grades will be awarded and
 reflected in the Achievement Record.



Note:

- There may be some changes in the above mentioned list as per the need of the school.
- CBSE recommends a minimum of 220 working days in an academic session. If required, the school may function on holidays and/or Sundays to complete the syllabus / conduct examinations.
- Considering the safety of the students, school will be called off on the account of bandh, bad weather conditions or any other unprecedented events, if felt necessary.







- · Parents can pay fees monthly, quarterly or yearly as per their convenience and in the dates listed.
- The school fees are to be paid in the designated bank by cheque or Bank draft, using the printed bank vouchers given to the parents.
- · Parents should submit the school copy of the voucher to the class teacher on the next day of the payment.
- The parents copy of the fee voucher should be preserved carefully and shown to the school whenever requested by the school office.
- Parents are requested to ensure that they fill up all the details like name, class, Section, Gr.No. and date
 on the voucher correctly.
- Parents are requested to extend their co-operation by paying the fee on time, and comply with above instructions.

- 1. They should take good care of their health and be robust and strong.
- 2. They should always be friendly with others in and outside the school.
- 3. They should be polite and well behaved.
- 4. They should accept whatever work is assigned to them as their rightful share. They should face difficulties courageously.

- 14. English being the mode of instructions it is expected of all the students that they interact in English.
- 15. Students are expected to be ready to pick up good habits and discard the bad ones; learn social manners and prepare themselves for healthy citizenship in a democratic society.



We believe that all the students have the right to be educated in an environment where there is a mutual respect and co-operation. Bullying is contrary to this approach and we do everything possible to discourage it.

Bullying is when someone deliberately goes out of their way to threaten, frighten, abuse or hurt someone else. It is also taunting or name calling as well as damaging a person's property, clothing or school work. It is ganging up on someone and isolating them.

School is committed to opposing bullying. Any form of the behaviour outlined below should never be ignored but challenged and the appropriate action taken.

Every pupil has the right to feel safe, secure, happy and free from intimidation.

Bullying can be defined as:

- malicious gossip
- verbal threats and abuse
- intimidating behaviour causing fear, concern or isolation
- aggressive physical contact
- interference with personal belongings
- · sexual, racial, social or disability harassment
- exclusion of the victim from group membership
- written comments including those posted on social networking sites
- graffiti in the school washroom, corridors and classrooms.

It can be defined as bullying if physically or emotionally harmful actions are repetitive, wilful or persistent are intentionally harmful and carried out by an individual or a group; if there is an imbalance of power leaving the person who is bullied feeling defenceless.

DO NOTE THE FOLLOWING

- 1. In order to maintain equality and uniformity, it is compulsory for the students to wear the complete prescribed school uniform.
- 2. Students not adhering to wearing of proper school uniform will not be entertained in the school.
- 3. Black ribbons / bands to be used by girls. for Sikh boys the colour of the turban is black.
- 4. Girls of class III upwards must wear black cycling shorts under the divided-skirt. Nursery to class II must wear bloomers.
- 5. Watches can only be worn from class VI onwards. fancy and expensive watches are not allowed.
- 6. All students (Primary) must carry one clean white handkerchief daily. They must deposit a table mat & yoga mat with the class teacher.
- 7. For students of Pre-Primary, two sets of aprons and napkins need to be deposited with the class teacher. They should bear the name of the child or have an identification mark that the child can recognize. It will be sent home every Friday, to be washed and brought back on Monday.
- 8. Girls having long hair must tie their hair into two plaits (for Nursery to class VIII) and girls of classes IX and X can tie single plait.
- 9. Improper turn out is undesirable and will lead to serious consequences.
- 10. Class V onwards boys should wear trousers.
- 11. The students are expected to come in the proper school uniform. No colourful sweaters, slacks or pullovers are allowed.

Coming to school regularly is an integral part of student's life. This inculcates discipline and regularity in a student. Students will be allowed to enter the class without an absence note in Almanac if he/she has been absent on the previous day.

Leave of Absence:

- Parents should submit an application through the Almanac well in advance and are strongly advised to apply for leave of absence before they confirm their holiday arrangements. Under no circumstances absences for family holidays in term time will be authorised after they have happened.
- 2. Students who have been sick for 3 or more days will bring a medical certificate from their doctor on re-joining the School.
- 3. All the students will attend school on the reopening day after each of the vacations. Those absent on account of any illness must present a medical certificate before they are admitted to the class. It is compulsory for all the students to maintain regular attendance during the course of the Academic Session, 80% attendance is mandatory to enable them to appear for the Final Assessment. A certificate of merit will be given to students with 100% attendance.
- 4. If a child is absent from the school without the prior information for 7 days continuously then his/her name will be struck off from the attendance register.
- 5. Leave on Assessment should be strictly avoided as it may hamper the child's Academic progress and Promotion to higher class.
- 6. Students are responsible for making up all work missed during the period of their absence.
- 7. No student will be allowed to leave the school campus during the school hours. However, in case of any emergency, the parent(s) / guardian should come to the school with an application, explaining the reason to take the ward(s). If the Principal / Vice-Principal / Headmistress is satisfied with the explanation, the ward(s) may be allowed to go after filling the performa concerned in duplicate.
- 8. No student who was absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without the permission of the class teacher.
- 9. No leave of absence is granted except on medical grounds.
- 10. Reported absence without granted leave or unexplained absence for six consecutive working days will result in the student's name being struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted at the discretion of the Principal, only on payment of fresh admission fee.
- 11. Attendance on the re-opening day after each of the vacations is compulsory.
- 12. Medical grounds: In case the child is seriously sick and remains absent for two or more than two consecutive working days he/she will have to produce the medical fitness certificate from a competent authority.
- 13. Any mishappening in the family-Under both the above mentioned conditions it is the duty of the parents to inform the school well in time. Medical leave: If absent for more than 5 days.
- 14. A student returning to school after suffering from an infectious/ contagious disease should produce a doctor's certificate of fitness to attend classes. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.

a) Chicken pox : Till scabs fall completely

b) Cholera : Till the child is completely well

c) Conjunctivitis : Till redness in the eyes completely disappears

d) Measles : Two weeks after the rashes disappear
e) Mumps : Until swelling has gone (about one month)

f) Whooping Cough: Six weeks

A discharge slip alongwith the other related documents will be required from the hospital in case a student has been hospitalised for any disease (e.g. jaundice, typhoid, malaria etc.)

15. No re-examination will be held for the students who remain absent in any of the examination.



The transport facility provided by Amrut Indian School, will cover majority of areas within Ahmedabad, but it will not be obligatory on the part of the school authorities to make new routes or to extend routes or to create additional stops.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Students must travel by the route that is allotted to them. No change will be allowed in between the session. Shifting to a new locality does not entitle the child to use a different school vehicle without permission from the school authorities. Allotment of a seat is subjected to availability.
- 11. Parents are requested to ensure that the student is escorted to and from the bus stop. The escort must be at the stop before the arrival of the bus. Bus will not wait for more than a minute for pickup or drop off. The students are expected to arrive at the pick-up point before time prior to the bus arrival. Bus drivers will not personally call parents in case if student is late for pickup or drop off.
- 2. Eating in the buses or littering is not permitted.
- Strict discipline to be maintained in the buses while travelling to school. Behaviour in the bus should be courteous. Talking aloud and moving up and down is not permitted. More than one complaint of indiscipline in the bus will result in withholding / withdrawing the transport facility of the child.
- 4. A Transport Declaration form is required to be filled in by the parent for each student using the school transport available at the school office.
- 5. Students will face disciplinary action (withdrawal of bus service) for any damage to buses caused by negligence or vandalism and fined accordingly.
 - Bullying of any form is a serious offence and will result in serious repercussion to the extent of withdrawal of bus facility / expulsion from school.
- 6. For Safety reasons:
 - (a Students should stand away from the main road.
 - (b) No body part should be outside the window.
 - (c) The driver's attention should not be distracted for any reason.
 - (d) No student should come near the door until the bus stops
- 7. Parents/guardians should neither enter the bus nor stop it at any destination apart from the Predestined stoppage and should not disrupt functioning of the bus.
- 8. Communication regarding transport to be done with the Transport Incharge only. Parents are requested not to communicate with the drivers or conductors or any staff members at all.
- 9. No monetary transactions or exchange of materials to be done through school bus drivers / conductors or any school employee outside the school campus.
- 10. An application for the route change to be submitted to the school transport in charge a week prior & hence immediate route change will not be permitted.
- 11. Nodal point will be assigned nearest to the home in area of 500 mts.
- 12. The School Transport Department reserves the right to deny or stop the transport facility.
- 13. Bus Conductor has the authority to assign seats to the students. The students are expected to remain seated while bus is in motion.
- 14. No student is allowed to change the bus without the prior permission, under which Transport Dept will not be responsible for any mishaps.
- 15. The Bus Route follows minimum 1 hour rule for the entire route for pickup & drop off.
- 16. School Transport Department reserves the right to change route timings and parents will be informed accordingly.





- 1. Parents who wish to withdraw their ward in the mid of the session need to pay the current quarter fee.
- 2. Parents who wish to withdraw their ward at the end of the session have to submit the application for TC by 15th Feb of the current academic session. If the TC application is submitted after 15th Feb then one quarter (new academic session) fees will be charged.
- 3. Transfer Certificate will be issued after all the dues are cleared and clearance form is completed.
- 4. Students can be asked to leave the school for the following reasons:
- a. Indiscipline.
- b. Delay / repetitive failure in payment of fee.
- c. Absence without fee.
- d. Unsatisfactory progress in academics.
- e. Non-adherence to school rules and regulations.
- f. Possession of prohibited items like liquor, drugs, firearms and illicit articles.
- 5. For the withdrawal of transport services, one month prior written notice is essential.



- 1. To qualify in a subject a student has to secure (separately in Theory and Practical) at-least 33% in both of the followings:
- (a) Annual Examination Marks
- (b) Cumulative Marks [20% of (Weekly Tests Marks) + 30% of (Half-Yearly Examination Marks) + 50% of (Annual Examination Marks)]
- 2. If a student fails to qualify in only one subject he / she is placed in compartment in that subject. In that case, Annual Examination Marks will be replaced by the Compartment Examination Marks and then the criterion stated in point no. 2 will be applied for promotion.
- 3. If a student fails to qualify in more than one subject he / she will be detained in class IX.
- 4. The Compartment Examination will be held after a minimum of 10 days from the result declaration day.

Results of the students will be withheld under the following conditions:

- (a) Non clearance of fees till 15th March of the financial year.
- (b) Library books not returned.
- (c) Attendance is below 75%.



The students of the school are divided into four houses with each house headed by a House In - charge and a team of teachers and house prefects.

Each House is headed by a student designated as House Captain. A member of the staff, assisted by the several other teachers (tutors), acts as the House Warden. Points are awarded to the students throughout the year for their performance in extracurricular activities, games and sports. Points are also awarded to individual students and groups for their performance in competitions.

Inter-House competitions are organised and trophies are awarded to the Houses for their performance in literary, cultural and sports activities. Every outstanding student is given a certificate for his/her performance in these competitions.

House competitions and activities form a regular routine at school. Participation is encouraged through various inter-house competitions in creative and performing arts, literary activities, academic as well as sports and special assemblies, thereby, developing confidence in the members of the house to showcase their talents and abilities. A healthy competitive and team spirit is thus inculcated and encouraged in every child. Houses are allotted to the students from class I.

- The final assessment of the students for promotion shall be decided on the weightage record of the student based on 100 marks.
- If a student is not able to appear for the whole or part of any examination for valid and accepted reasons, his promotion will be entirely at the discretion of the Principal and her decision will be final.
- No child will be permitted to leave the school after class test.



The school curriculum leads to sound academic growth. However, involvement in co-curricular activities is an essential part of schooling.

- 6. Reading Scheme Activities: Students are exposed to words, sentences, stories as per their level, so that they enjoy hearing, repeating and understanding and demonstrating.
- 7. Personality Development Programme (PDP): Paper Presentation, Radio Talks, Lectures and Seminars, Communication Skills in English, Manners and Etiquette and Value Education.
- 8. Audio Visual Learning Supplement: Learning by doing is the call of the day, especially for the junior classes. The school enriches the curriculum with AV aids to ensure better understanding and retention.
- 9. Students Counselling: School caters to counselling and guidance of students in developing their personality and shaping career.
- 10. Language Enrichment, Mental Maths and General Awareness Tests are conducted to enhance Linguistic skills, Mental Mathematical aptitude and General awareness.
- 11. Yoga and Diya Meditation: Great emphasis is given to yoga and Diya Meditation to bolster up the power of concentration, accentuate memory power and balance Physical / Mental aspect.
